## **Overview**

The Midwest Augustinians have an immediate opening for a Director of Augustinian Lay Engagement. ## Specific Duties

- Create programming for Augustinian Affiliates to keep them involved in the life of the Order.
- Coordinate the Men's and Women's Retreat programs. and integrating Catholic Social Teaching.
- Develop content and experiences to promote the Augustinian mission, heritage, and traditions.
- Assist the Advancement Office in generating content on spirituality, religious life, and other Augustinian themes for print and social media use.

- Four-year degree from an accredited university or college.
- Strong spoken and written communication skills.
- Knowledge of the Augustinian mission.
- Cultural sensitivity.
- Ability to develop youth and young adult programming.
