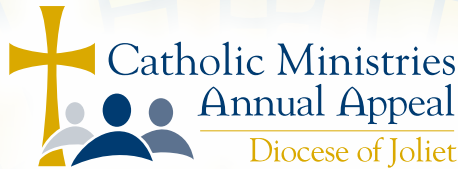


2024 CMAA Closing Impact Report

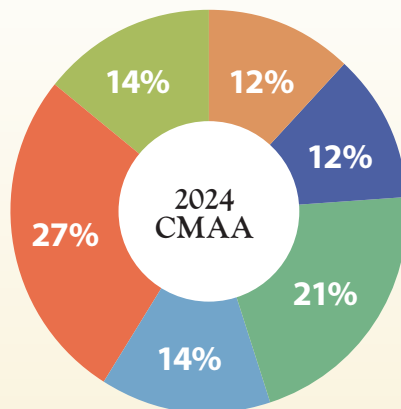
