Twenty-eight faithful Deaf persons from IL, MI, WI, and even Minnesota attended.



The purpose of this Deaf Lenten Retreat was to rejuvenate ourselves mentally, spiritually and physically. During the weekend there was a workshop presented by Rev. Christopher Klusman, meals, tours to museum and shrine of St. Therese of Liseux, confessions, fellowships, a Kahoot Lenten Trivia game and Vigil Mass in The Carmelite Spiritual Center provided a serene place for the guests to stay, to spend time reflecting on our lives, and developing a relationship with the Lord. This retreat weekend wasn't meant to be a substitute for real life. Rather, it was meant to be a way to send us out into the world recharged mentally, spiritually and physically to face the challenges ahead of us with the help of our devoted, featherly winged angels!


"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." – Jeremiah 29:11.




