

**Job Title:** Coordinator of Youth Ministry  
**Reports To:** Pastor

### **Job Summary**

Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Parish in beautiful downtown Naperville is looking for a dynamic youth minister to lead High School and Junior High youth programs that inspire and equip students to follow Jesus Christ in the Catholic Church. The youth minister forms young people through catechesis, prayer, service, and social opportunities.

### **Responsibilities**

- *To teach towards conversion* in two weekly meetings (Junior High and High School) that include prayer, catechesis, and fellowship. Students should learn the “whys” of the Catholic faith especially regarding hot-button issues. Help students pray by guided meditation, the rosary, or other methods from Catholic Tradition.
- *To organize service opportunities* that integrate the Gospel into students’ lives. Examples include working with the Little Sisters of the Poor, organizing a mission trip, volunteering at the parish, etc.
- *To offer social opportunities* for students such as movie nights, bowling, etc.
- *To plan spiritual retreats*, giving students the opportunity to meet Jesus and deepen their relationship with Him. Trips to Steubenville Conferences, the March for Life, NCYC, and parish-organized retreats are suitable.
- *To manage a youth ministry budget*, including maintaining financial records and basic fundraising (i.e. a bake sale).
- *To train youth leaders and chaperones* who can assist in youth ministry and abide by safe environment standards.
- *Work in tandem with* the Parish School and Religious Education to welcome 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders into youth ministry. Examples include leading the pro-life club, being present at lunch or recess, and speaking in classes.
- *Must support the* mission, values, philosophy and policies of the Roman Catholic Church and the Diocese of Joliet.

### **Qualifications**

- Catholic in good standing with the Church, supporting her doctrine and moral teachings.
- Degree in Theology, Catechetics, or equivalent formation.
- Competent in administration and teaching.
- Comfortable communicating with parishioners and personnel of all ages.
- Creative with the capacity to design programs and engage the parish.

- Experience in youth ministry is preferred.
- Compliant with Safe Environment (Virtus) standards.

### **Compensation**

Salary range is \$40,000 - \$54,000 depending on experience.

### **Benefits**

We offer a competitive benefits package that includes:
